DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The Sunday after Easter is also the Sunday of Divine Mercy. Devotions for Divine Mercy will be prayed today at 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

The novena of Divine Mercy began on Good Friday and ends today.

The title “Divine Mercy Sunday” has its roots in the writings of a poor Polish nun, Saint Faustina Kowalska, and her revelations about God’s mercy. Her message is that God is merciful and loving and so must we be to others. When St. Faustina was canonized in 2000, Pope John Paul II decreed this Sunday to be Divine Mercy Sunday.

NEOPHYTE MASS

The Neophyte Mass will take place on Sunday, May 4th at the 12 pm Mass with Bishop Bergie. We welcome all those who were baptized and received into the Catholic Church at Easter.

THE EASTER SEASON

The seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost are celebrated as one great feast day. Christians sing the Alleluia during these days in their rejoicing. The church celebrates for fifty days, culminating with the feast of Pentecost – calling all to service, mission and to evangelization.

THE EASTER CANDLE

The Paschal Candle is a reminder of the presence of the Risen Christ among the people of God. It remains in the Sanctuary until Pentecost Sunday, June 8th.
