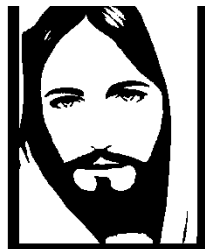
The mass on Monday August 1st be at 10 am and the Cathedral Office will be closed.
