As we prepare to begin a new liturgical year beginning in the season of Advent, we look for opportunities to deepen our love for Our Blessed Lord, who will be coming at Christmas. There are two extra activities that will be beginning this Advent at the Cathedral. First, on Saturday Morning there will be confessions offered from 10am to 11am. If this turns out to be a time that works well, we will keep it throughout the year. Secondly, on Thursday evenings at 7:30 pm, we will be continuing our study on Dantes by going through the final book, the Paradiso. The first session will begin Thursday December 7th. Even if you have not participated in the previous studies of the Inferno and Purgatorio, you are still more than welcome to join.

DECEMBER 8TH

December 8th is the beautiful Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. To fittingly celebrate this beautiful feast day in honour of our Blessed Mother, everyone is welcome to come join His Excellency, Bishop Bergie, as he celebrates Mass that evening at 7pm at the Cathedral. Immediately following the Mass there will be a candlelight rosary procession, with the statue of our Lady.
