EASTER SEASON - FIFTY DAYS

The seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost are celebrated as one great feast day. St. Athanasius called them "The Great Sunday." Christians sing the Alleluia during these days in their rejoicing. The Easter Alleluia is an enthusiastic and joyful Acclamation announcing victory over death, the promise of a new life, the presence of the risen Lord. The Church celebrates for fifty days, culminating with the feast of Pentecost - calling all to Service, to Mission and to Evangelization.

THE POPES PASTORAL WORKS May 5th

This Collection provides an opportunity for Catholics to make a financial offering to assist the Holy Father. Onethird of the funds collected is for what is traditionally known as Peter's pence: donations used by the Pope for his charitable contributions to those most in need. Twothirds of the collections is to support the Holy Father in administering the Holy See and serving the Universal Church.
