CATHEDRAL OUT OF THE COLD

Cathedral Out of the Cold ended its 29th season on March 31st. Open every Tuesday night from November 4th, volunteers served 4,613 meals. The projected increase year over year did not happen with 134 fewer meals served. This is the second year that guests chose to eat in or take away. Many preferred to take their meal home while others ate in, warmed up and connected. Donations of socks, hats, scarves, hand warmers and other items were given out and gratefully received. Gloves were in short supply. Pet food was unexpected and very welcome. Volunteers continued to do all the work. Without them these meals could not continue. Yeah Team! Donations



were much appreciated and covered 100% of the costs. The faithful support of the Cathedral parish has continued through many years and is so necessary for the continuation of this ministry. Volunteers and guests are very thankful for the support Cathedral Out of the Cold receives and God willing plans to open again Tuesday, November 3, 2026.
