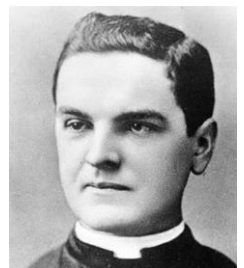
### **ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS**
